



## Hiking & TrailRider Experience

### Overview

RMA caters Hiking & TrailRiders Experiences for groups of all ability levels and specific needs of the group, providing an opportunity to explore new heights and trails.

### Event Details

Your group will meet the RMA team at the specified location and prepare for the hike. A briefing will go over the hike details and safety protocols. TrailRiders may be provided for individuals with mobility challenges and will be guided by the RMA team. The TrailRider itself is a 1 wheeled device that can be used on varied terrain. The TrailRider must be guided by a trained staff or volunteers and can not be used completely independently by the guest. After taking to the trail, a lunch spot will be chosen. After lunch, the hikers will return to the trailhead.

### Requirements

TrailRiders may be provided for individuals with limited mobility. Hiking location will be determined based on the ability of your group and whether or not a TrailRider will be utilized for your group's hike. Hike location may have to change last minute, due to wildlife warnings, weather conditions, or other unforeseen circumstances.

**Skill Level:** We welcome all abilities and skill levels.

**Gear:** Waterproof shoes/boots suitable for hiking, warm & waterproof layers, rain jacket,,, backpack and extra layers.sunscreen, poles (optional).

**Other:** Each individual will be required to be fitted for ski boots, skis, and helmets prior to lesson time. All guests must complete health information and waiver forms. Caregivers and Program Leads must complete a Waiver.
